

DANIELLE KNELL 4-H MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Currently a 4-H or FFA member in Carroll County;
2. Be a graduating senior or high school graduate;
3. Be accepted at or already attending college or post secondary school
4. Must have shown or exhibited livestock in the Carroll County Program; (Horse, Goat, or Chicken exhibitors)
5. Applicant must have completed units for the previous year's livestock projects and must submit completed units with the scholarship application. **This should match the activity in #4**

Selection will be based on:

1. 4-H/FFA accomplishments, 4-H/FFA participation, financial need and high school/college grades.
2. Applicant must furnish a transcript of high school as well as college grades if college courses have been taken.
3. Two letters of recommendation; one from a high school teacher/college professor and one from a 4-H leader or educator. See form attached
4. Decision of the selection committee will be final.
5. All candidates must be interviewed.
6. Selection committee may decide not to award a scholarship if there are no worthy applicants.

The amount of the scholarship is (**You may set a fixed amount or it may vary from year to year depending on available funds**) and the scholarship will only be awarded once to each individual. However, if extra money is available winners may be eligible for a second scholarship based on service to the 4-H program during the following year.

Scholarships will be announced at the 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale at the Carroll County Fair.
