The Baker-Yingling Athletic Scholarship Fund

The Baker-Yingling Athletic Scholarship Fund was established by the Saint John Boys Basketball Committee as a tribute to long time coaches and coordinators, Larry Baker and Donald “Bo” Yingling.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Fund is to provide scholarships for children involved in the athletic programs at St. John Roman Catholic Community in Westminster, Maryland.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit checks made payable to the appropriate schools or camp authorities, on or about August 15th of each year. The transfer will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

- A. The scholarship winner(s) will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in this document and the Scholarship Fund Agreement. It is a one-time award, applicant is not eligible for further B/Y scholarship funds.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner.
- C. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall submit an annual financial report to St. John’s Athletic Scholarship Committee.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

A. Scholarship(s) will be awarded each year to the student(s) who meets the following criteria:

- The Student shall be a participant in the St. John's Roman Catholic Community Parish Athletic Program for at least three (3) years;
- Exhibit exemplary character;
- Complete application and provide all requested information;
- Be accepted by a College, University, or Catholic High School

B. The administration of the scholarship shall be as follows:

- The recipient shall be nominated by the St. John Athletic Scholarship Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
- The St. John's Athletic Scholarship Committee will provide the Community Foundation of Carroll County with the nominated student's name.
- All income generated from the Scholarship Fund shall be used for the scholarship award.
- The amount and number of the awards may vary based upon the earnings of the Fund.
- The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the school officials and applied directly to the student's fees. The monies shall not be remitted to the scholarship winner directly.
- The Community Foundation of Carroll County in conjunction with St. John Athletic Scholarship Committee will determine the application process.
