

CRITERIA

THE BETHANY SHAY GREEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of this fund is to honor the life of Bethany Shay Green by providing scholarship(s) for a Westminster High School a female graduating senior who has shown academic achievement and participated in the Softball, Volleyball and or Basketball programs and who has been accepted at an accredited College, University or Technical School.

Applications will also be accepted from continuing students, i.e. those already in college from Westminster High School who meet the criteria established for this scholarship.

FUND SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. Funds will be awarded to female applicants who meet the following criteria:
 - 1. A resident of Carroll County, Maryland graduating from Westminster High School with an academic GPA of at least 3.0;
 - 2. A student who has participated in softball, volleyball and or basketball at Westminster High School;
 - 3. A student who has demonstrated school and community spirit in her extra curricular activities;
 - 4. A student who has demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities in and outside athletics.

- B. The administration of the Fund shall be as follows:
 - 1. The recipient(s) shall be selected by the scholarship Advisory Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County. Donors reserve the right to make the award presentation.
 - 2. All income generated from the Fund shall be used for fund purposes.
 - 3. The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

The Community Foundation will transmit checks made payable to the institutions of higher learning chosen on or about July 15 of each year. The transfers will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BOARD:

- A. The successful scholarship recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be commingled with other funds of the Foundation.
