

**I. VIRGINIA AND E. CARROLL MURRAY SCHOLARSHIP
CRITERIA**

PURPOSE:

To benefit a student who is considered by the selection committee as most likely to successfully adapt to and complete a college program of study leading to a degree.

BACKGROUND:

The scholarship is established for a graduation senior of Manchester Valley HS in the names of I. Virginia Murray and E. Carroll Murray. Mrs. Murray was a teacher and principal at Manchester Elementary School. She later became Supervisor of Elementary Schools in Carroll County.

AMOUNT:

The annual award will be the sum of 2,500 dollars which will be credited to the recipient for use in the payment of tuition and textbook costs to an accredited college or university of the recipient's choice.

The funds will be disbursed by the Trustee directly to the college or university upon presentation by the recipient of invoices for tuition or textbooks, or directly to the recipient upon presentation of invoices marked "paid," if said invoices cover then current semester or term of classes.

The recipient shall be required to expend all funds in successive semesters of classes (excluding summer semesters). Any interruption of classes for a semester, except where said interruption shall have been caused by the health or physical condition of the recipient, shall operate as a forfeiture of any funds. Remaining funds shall be debited to the recipient's account and credited to the Trust income account.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The recipient shall be a Manchester Valley HS Senior (formerly a North Carroll HS senior). In the event that North Carroll High School is merged, or for any reason loses its identity, the recipient shall be a high school senior residing in the North Carroll High School District as it existed on March 1, 1978.

The recipient is not limited to the field of study he/she may pursue.

The recipient need not show financial need,

The recipient will be considered according to the following:

Academic courses taken in high school

SAT scores

Grade point average

Extra-curricular involvement

Application
