



Criteria
The Jared Lutz Memorial Scholarship

Purpose: The purpose of this Fund is to honor the life of **Jared Lutz** by providing scholarship(s) for a Liberty High School graduating senior who has shown academic achievement and has participated in the Academy of Health in the Nursing Sciences Program at Carroll County Career and Technology Center. The successful candidate will have been accepted at an accredited College or University. Applications will also be accepted from continuing students, i.e., those already in college from Liberty High School who meet the FUND selection criteria.

FUND Selection Criteria:

- A. Funds will be awarded to an applicant who meets the following criteria:
 - 1. The student will be a current graduating senior at Liberty High School accepted at an accredited college or university, or a former graduate of Liberty High School currently enrolled at an accredited college or university, pursuing a degree in nursing.
 - 2. The student will have participated in the Academy of Health in the Nursing Sciences Program at Carroll County Career and Technology Center.
 - 3. The student will have maintained a GPA of 3.0 for their high school or college career.
 - 4. The student will have demonstrated a commitment to community service or charity work.
 - 5. The student(s) will provide a two-page essay explaining their interest in nursing, their commitment to earning a college degree and how participation in community service/charity work influenced their pursuit of a degree in nursing.
- B. The administration of the FUND shall be as follows:
 - 1. The recipient(s) shall be selected by the Donors or their designee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County. Donors reserve the right to make the award presentation.
 - 2. All income in the fund shall be used for fund purposes.
 - 3. The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the FUND recipient.

General Conditions:

A. Responsibilities of the FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit a check made payable to the institution of higher learning chosen on or about July 1 of each year. The transfers will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

B. Responsibilities of the Board

1. The successful student recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
2. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be commingled with other funds of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
